



The new IPC-3 computer is equipped with 2GB flash memory. The Operating System, Windows XP Embedded, and West-Com applications are installed on the flash memory. All your data and log files are stored on a hard drive. If, by any chance, your hard drive should go down, all your data files are automatically restored to the flash memory by means of the West-Call® Data Manager. The West-Call® IPC-3 is robust and way more failsafe than any conventional computer. It's an industrial grade, fanless computer that weighs about five pounds and is easy to mount. It runs on an Intel Pentium-M processor running at 1.4 GHZ with 512MB RAM. It basically won't wear out.
